1. The admission of children to the exhibition of any film will be restricted in accordance with Section 20 (1) of the Act and the Council specifies the British Board of Film Classification as the classification body under Section 20 (2).

### Annex 2 - Conditions Consistent with the Operating Schedule

1. There shall be no adult entertainment or services, activities, other entertainment or matters ancillary to the use of the premises that may give rise to concern in respect of children.
2. All activities involving children shall be supervised by responsible adults.
3. Between the hours of 21:00 and 23:00 noise from the premises shall not exceed the levels in the following octave bands:

Hz	63	125	250	500	1000	2000	4000	8000
L dB	62	52	45	39	35	32	30	29

(Noise rating curve 35 formerly part of ISO 1996).

Measurement 1m from the façade of noise sensitive properties.

b) Between the hours of 23:00 to 00:00 Noise from the premises shall be inaudible in the nearest dwelling or other noise sensitive property.

4. Noise levels and measurement positions shall be agreed with the Environmental Health Officer of the Council.
5. Clear and legible notices shall be displayed at prominent positions adjacent to exits and other circulatory areas requesting patrons to leave the premises having regard to the needs of local residents, in particular emphasising the need to refrain from shouting, slamming car doors and the sounding of car horns.
